With an ideal location, just 25 minutes from the heart of Rome, our **organic farm** offers luxury apartments to rent in a grand hacienda surrounded by 70 hectares of farmland with rows of hazelnut and olive trees and a breeding facility for quarter horses. Nestled in the pristine environment of the **Bracciano and Martignano Nature Reserve**, our accommodations provide all the comforts of home with a meticulous attention to detail. Lake Martignano, just a few metres from Potrero Grande, adds to the pastoral atmosphere and creates a perfect environment for the local animal and plant life to thrive, making this one of Italy's most beautiful oases of unspoiled nature. Potrero Grande is the perfect spot for anyone who wants to experience the charms of the Eternal City but prefers to wake up in the lush serenity of the Roman countryside.



The Apartments



The apartments in Potrero Grande range from 50m2 to 105m2 and sleep between two and six people, with air conditioning, wifi, **modern kitchens** and bathrooms. They are ideal for couples, families or groups of friends, who are into

sports, culture or just relaxation. Our apartments are available for hire on a weekly basis or you can rent the entire hacienda for events and special occasions.

The ranch also provides food and shelter for horses that accompany their owners on holiday. Our modern stables are equipped with wash bays, UV lamps, a lighted outdoor arena and an evergreen paddock tucked between the kiwi orchard and the lake. Within a 10km radius, you can find Le Rughe shopping center with a pharmacy, a post office, a petrol station, cash machines; also car rental offices, pizzerias and other traditional restaurants, nature parks, archaeological sites, ancient Roman villages and two of Italy's best golf courses.



Lake Martignano



"The Pearl of the Sabatini Hills", Lake Martignano lies in an extinct volcanic crater 207 metres above sea level and was very popular among the ancient Romans. Emperor Augustus built the region's first aqueduct to supply water for the naval battle reenactments in Trastevere in Rome. Thanks to its distance from major roads and human settlements, and for not allowing motor boats to get into the lake, it is a miracle of ecological purity.



Next to the Potrero Grande farmhouse is the **Casale di Martignano** bio-restaurant, with fresh, organic food and a beautiful **lawn beach** with sailboats, canoes and pedal boats for hire. Sunset drinks and Italian aperitivo are also available during summer. This magical place is perfect for receptions for any occasion.



There are also walking, cycling and riding trails between Lake Martignano and Lake Bracciano, characterized by landscapes of gorges and vertical walls carved in volcanic rocks.



Around Potrero Grande

The town of **Calcata**, the Roman amphitheater of **Sutri** and the medieval castle of **Bracciano** are all within easy reach, as is St. Peter's Basilica in Rome, which is only 30 minutes away by car or train. For health enthusiasts, there are the Roman baths at **Terme dei Papi** in Viterbo. For golfers, the Olgiata **Golf Club** and Sutri Golf Nazionale are 15 minutes away, as is the **Vallelunga** Circuit for motorsports fans.

How to reach us

Strada di Martignano, Campagnano di Roma

By car from Rome: Take the G.R.A. and exit at Cassia Veientana towards Viterbo, then take the exit for Campagnano di Roma and turn left immediately passing under the bridge, then turn right towards Valle del Baccano. Go on for 2 km until you reach the street Strada di Martignano on your left. From there it is just a 2 km drive to Potrero Grande. On-site parking.
